Mr. Li studied and obtained master's degree at School of Economics and Management and School of Law, Tsinghua University and received bachelor's degree of Art in Language and Literature from Beijing Foreign Studies University. He also graduated from the MBA programme at the Chinese University of Hong Kong and was sponsored by government to study in many European countries. Mr. Li has worked in the top first and second tier market investment funds in China and the United States. He served in research and investment department at Tencent, as well as the Chief Researcher at Tencent Research Institute. He worked as the Assistant President of Kaisa Financial Group Holdings, one of the Top 500 Enterprises of China, responsible for strategic planning, also in charge of investment & financing, and operation in sectors of finance, technology and consumer. Mr. Li is also a lecturer for Ph.D. and Postgraduate programmes at Tsinghua-Berkeley Shenzhen College and the Chinese University of Hong Kong and is a council member of Tsinghua Alumni Association.
